

RTICLE VII. NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS

SECTION 9.01. Eligibility. Any active member in good standing of the RUTHERFORD COUNTY REPUBLICAN ASSEMBLY (RCRA) shall be eligible to hold any elective office, provided that the person is qualified under the Tennessee Republican Assembly Bylaws; but no person shall be submitted as a candidate for any office without his consent.

SECTION 9.02. Accredited Voters. Before the opening of polls, the Secretary shall provide a list of the Delegates and Delegates-at-Large as shown by the report of the Committee on Credentials. No Delegate shall be allowed to vote unless his name appears on the list.

SECTION 9.03. Ballots. Voting on endorsements or for officers of the RCRA shall be by ballot only, unless there is in the opinion of the convention Chairman a motion to hold the vote by standing agreed to by two thirds of the voting Delegates or Delegates at Large, or if the election is unopposed.

SECTION 9.04. Election of National Convention Delegates and Alternates. Any active member in good standing of the RUTHERFORD COUNTY REPUBLICAN ASSEMBLY (RCRA) shall be eligible to be elected as a Delegate or Alternate to the NFRA National Convention, provided that the person is qualified under the TRA Bylaws; but no person shall be submitted as a candidate without his consent.
